Reading with your 3-year-old

Reading with him now helps him get ready for school.

Point to a picture, and say "what's that?"

Point to a picture, and ask "What's happening?" What happens next?

Let her tell you the story if she wants to.

You don't have to read the words. Just talking to him about the story helps him learn.

Touch the words with your finger when you read.

Talk about words that start with the same sound, like "baby," "bottle," and "bath."

Talk about words that rhyme, like "sat," "cat," and "hat."
