Thirty years ago, two pediatricians at Boston City Hospital started giving their young patients books while sharing advice about the importance of reading aloud with their patients' families. Drs. Robert Needlman and Barry Zuckerman observed that many of their youngest patients were missing out on the opportunities for development in the critical first years of life. As pediatric pioneers, they partnered with early childhood educators, and leveraged their access to families with babies and toddlers to encourage reading aloud and integrate literacy promotion into the pediatric setting. From this first clinic serving 500 children and families in Boston, the Reach Out and Read model was born. Today, 34,000 pediatric providers at 6,400 clinical locations nationally, deliver our model, reaching 4.8 million children and families and distributing over **7.4 million new, children's books** every year. Incredible!

Our success today is a direct result of the generosity and passion of you, our donors. We are grateful that you have partnered with us on this journey to support our nation's children during their most formative years, the first five years of life. You have invested not only in the cognitive and social-emotional health of our nation's youngest children – you have also supported their parents and strengthened family bonds.

This is our Next Chapter. We look forward to writing this story with you.



Our clinicians love the rich repetition, familiar word patterns and the brightly colored artwork of Eric Carle. The simple story unfolds with asking a question of what the brown bear sees. The pictures not only teach color and object recognition but captivates the young reader to find out what comes next by turning the page. And at 12 months, understanding that pictures are symbols of real things is a first step toward understanding that print also represents ideas of items in the real world.


## **Financials**

Reach Out and Read continues to grow all lines of revenue, while maintaining a net operating surplus and increasing our operating reserves, creating financial strength and flexibility.


