#### **ROR Leadership Conference Required COVID-19 Rapid Testing:**

We require all Conference attendees to submit two negative COVID-19 tests (self-administered, electronically-submitted, confidentially-maintained, and subsequently-destroyed) within 24 hours prior to arrival at the Conference – and to take/submit these as far apart within those 24 hours as possible.

Additionally, we will require participants to take/submit a negative COVID-19 test for each additional day of attendance at the Conference. For most participants this means 2 tests within 24 hours of Wednesday 10/26, plus 1 test Thursday 10/27 by 6:30 am, and 1 final test Friday 10/28 by 6:30 am. (Please note: if you are arriving on Tuesday, you will need to submit 2 tests within 24 hours of Tuesday 10/25, plus 1 test Wednesday 10/26 by 6:30 am, 1 test Thursday 10/27 by 6:30 am, and 1 final test Friday 10/28 by 6:30 am).



- We recognize that plans for arrival time may differ across the network, and responsibility is with the individual to ensure that testing happens within this window and is submitted according to the guidelines. Participants are responsible for the cost of the two pre-arrival tests.
- For the during-Conference tests, ROR will pay for and provide these tests and Conference attendees can pick these up upon arrival (they are included in attendees' gift bags).
- Test results will be confidentially stored and destroyed after the event.
- There will be a designated person on site at the Leadership Conference who will ensure that negative tests are on file for all in order to participate in the Conference. If anyone submits a positive test, they will not be allowed to participate in the Conference.
